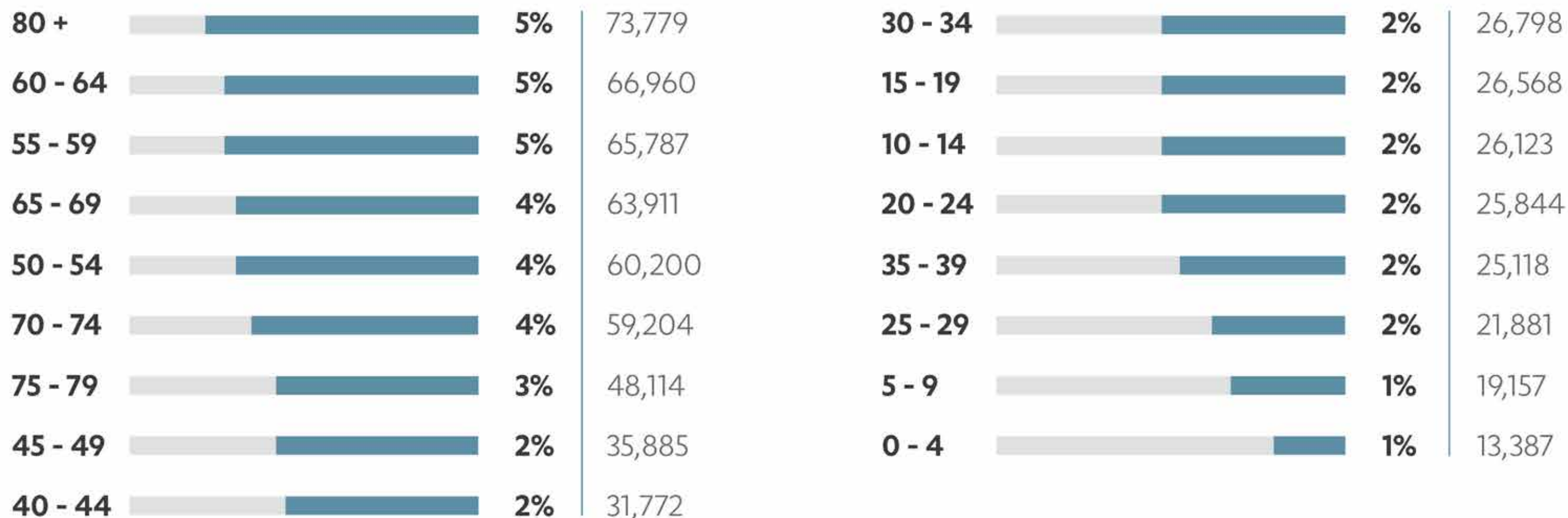
The **highest percentage** of people with disabilities **aged 50 and over** for male

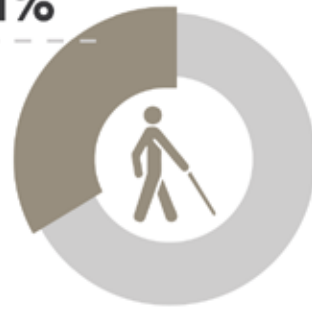

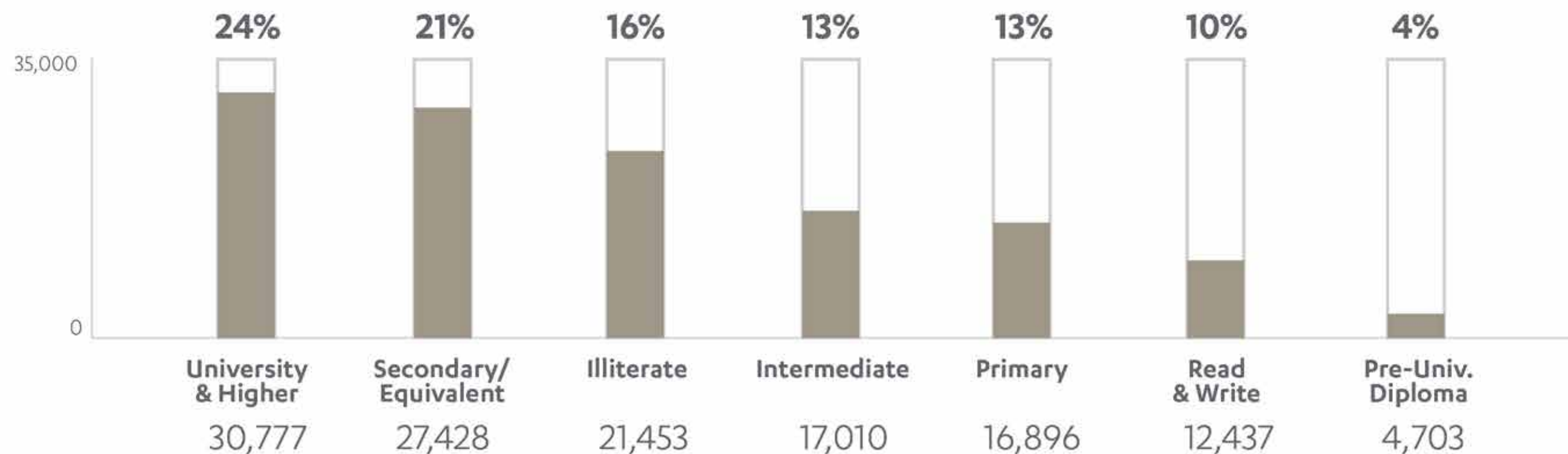


Most of male with seeing disability have

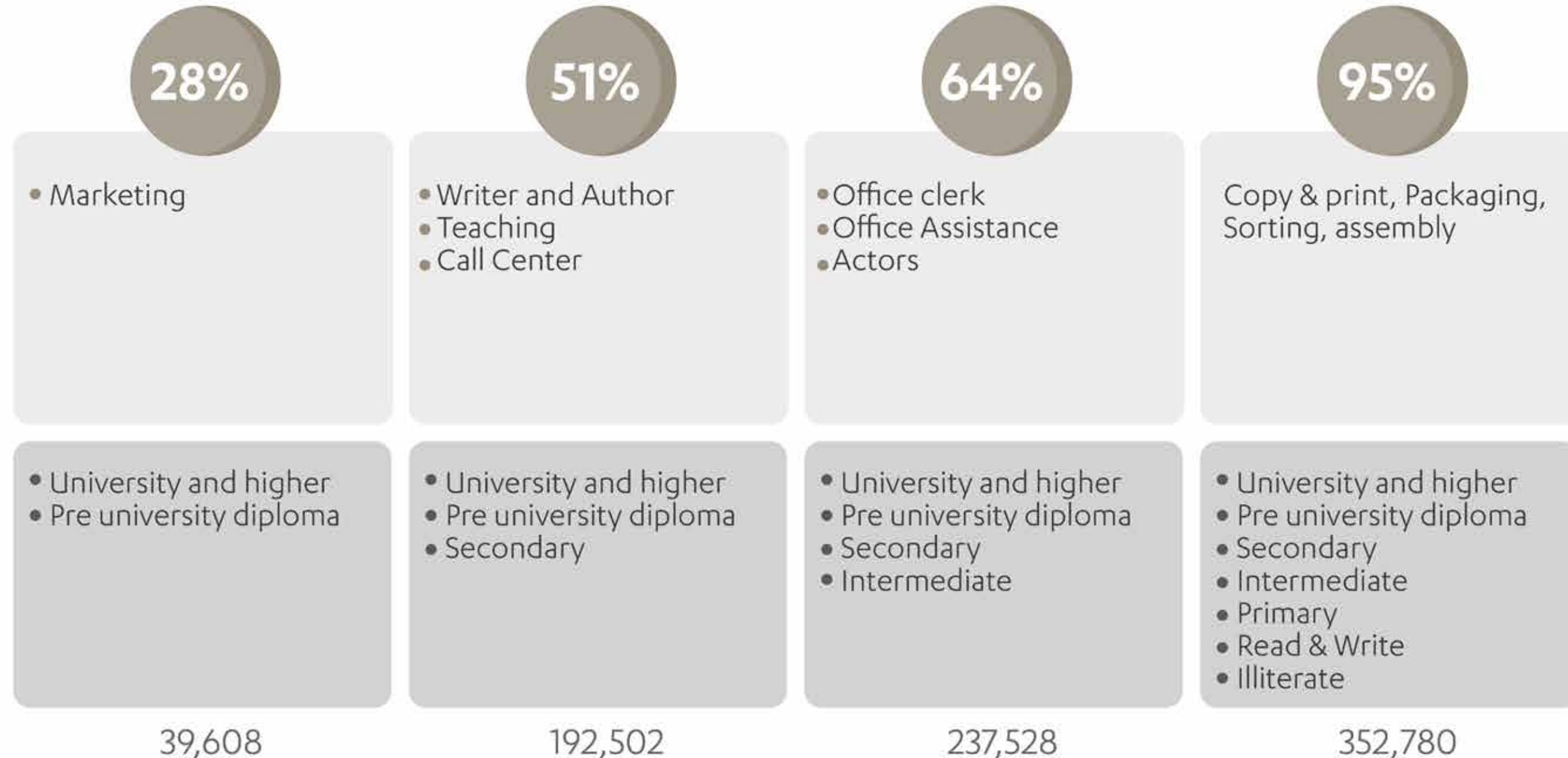


Most of male with motor disability have

they represents around **24%**



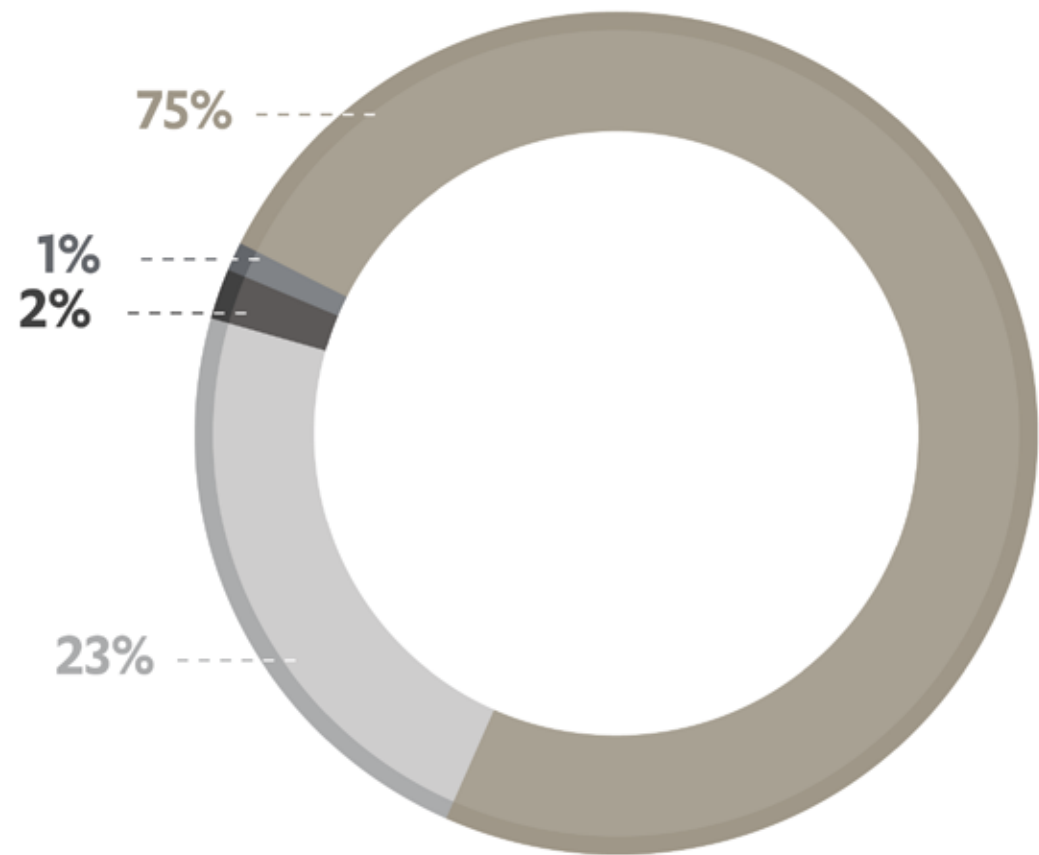

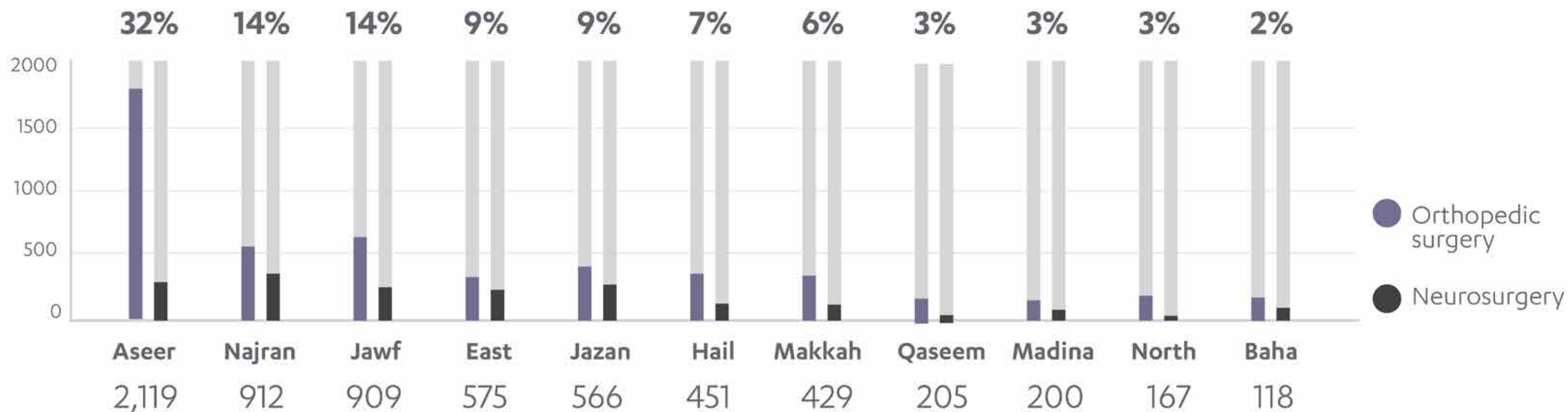


CASES OF TRAUMATIC BRAIN & SPINAL CORD INJURIES IN KSA



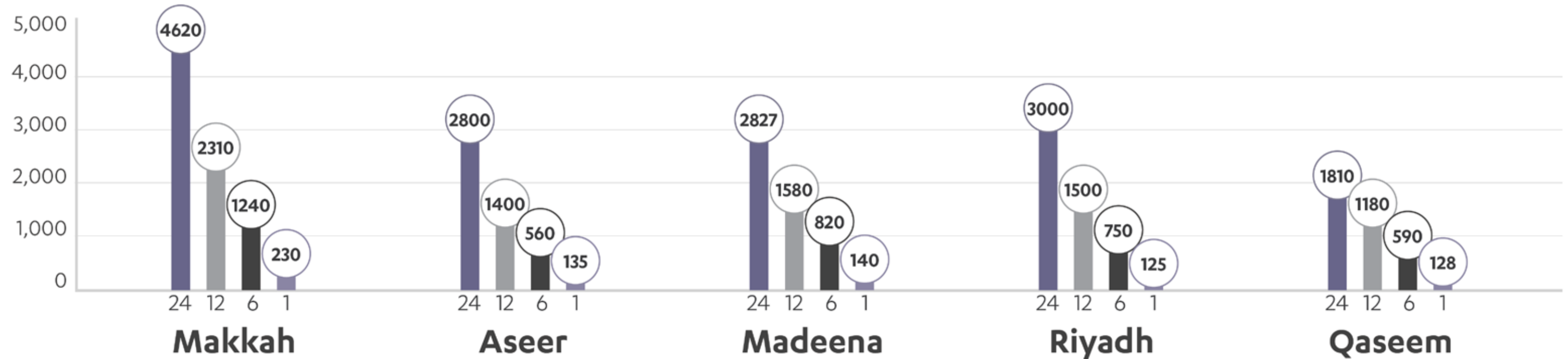


CASES OF TRAUMATIC BRAIN & SPINAL CORD INJURIES IN KSA



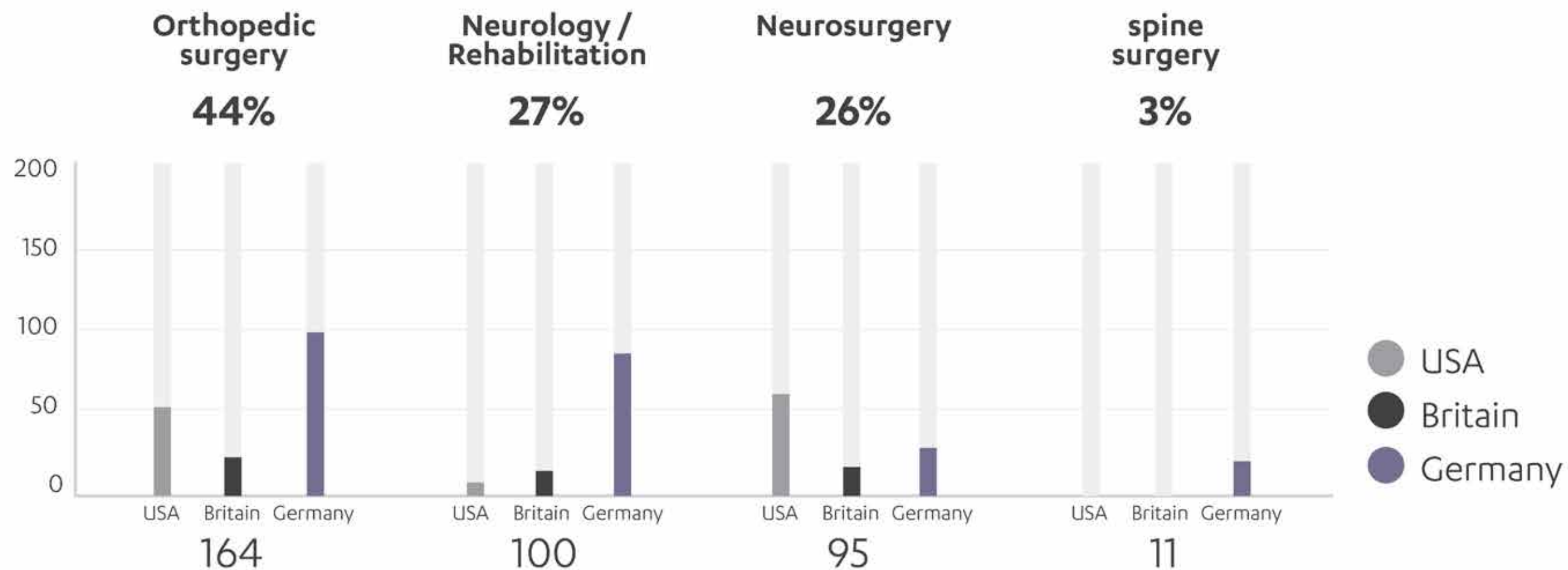


PRICES OF PHYSICAL THERAPY INSIDE KSA



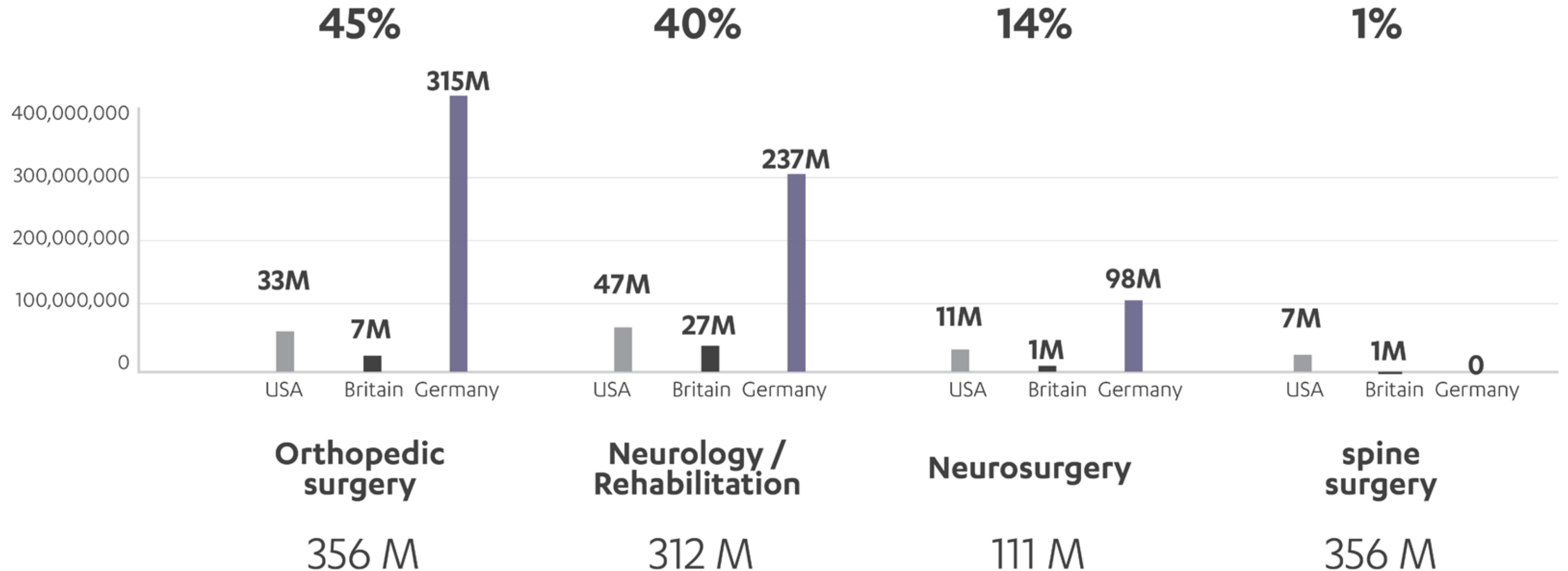


NUMBER OF DOMESTIC PATIENTS REARING TREATMENT ABROAD

TRADITIONAL PHYSIOTHERAPY



Physical therapy

is a comprehensive approach to prevention, diagnosis and treatment of problems and motor disorders With many method of treatments

Goal: Enable the patient to achieve the level of movement and health, stimulation the Fitness Health and muscle To minimize the effects of injury



Occupational therapy

It is a treatment for the daily life skills of people with physical, neurological or cognitive problems

Goal: Empower people with special needs and develop their capacities for independence and self-reliance in the practice of daily functions



TYPES OF PHYSICAL THERAPY

Hydro Therapy



Hydrotherapy is the use of exercise therapy within a specially designed pool to target and treat a wide spectrum of conditions. These include orthopedic conditions, neurological conditions, sports injuries and many more.

Therapeutic Exercise



Is a therapeutic exercises with sports tools to build physical strength and rehabilitation of the injured part to regaining range of motion. moreover Used to improve muscle function, bone and endurance, reduce pain,improve joints

Manual therapy



It is a manual therapy technique comprising a continuum of hand skilled movements to restore optimal motion, function, and/ or to reduce pain. include moving joints or vertebrae, muscle stretching , movements of the affected body part

Electrotherapy



Electrotherapy is a treatment that uses electric waves for treatment, is typically used in conjunction with other treatments. moreover used for relaxation of muscle spasms, muscle rehabilitation, management of pain, immediate post-surgical stimulation of muscles to prevent venous thrombosis

TRADITIONAL PHYSIOTHERAPY BY MEDICAL ROBOT

The efficiency of robot use in physical therapy is higher than the use of traditional physiotherapy; it helps people to walk again after a stroke or spinal injury. Artificial intelligence helps persons with disabilities regain movement after injury by stimulating the robot to nerve signals of the brain. The robot is the only therapeutic device that can teach the brain how to move the legs.

Saeed Al-Qaffaf

22-year-old student in software engineering at Prince Sultan University in Riyadh.

- Saeed suffers from cerebral palsy physically but Intellectually became the first youtuber in a wheelchair.
- He was able to assert that the will could be acquired and taken over when the person determined to do so, and was able to prove his competence and ability to challenge the disability; his disability prevented him from achieving his ambition to become the first Arab youtuber in a wheelchair.
- He adds that his motor disability has not prevented him from forming social relationships. He has many friends from the neighborhood where he lives, visits and goes out with him and talks to them constantly.

"My imagination carries many of the hopes and wishes I want to achieve, including being a spokesman for an institution TED".
